

Subject Pronouns en español - Gramática

What is a subject? A subject is a noun or pronoun that does the action in a sentence.

Amy writes letters. Who writes letters? Amy
Luis and Mario dance. Who dances? Luis & Mario
I love Spanish. Who loves Spanish? I

Subject pronouns are often used to replace the name of a subject.

Maria studies → **SHE** studies

Manuela and I eat tacos → **WE** eat tacos
