

# Subject Pronouns *en español*

The subject pronouns in Spanish are:

Singular

Plural

1st person

**Yo** = I

\*when talking *about* yourself

**Nosotros/Nosotras** = We

male/  
mixed group ↙

↳ all females

\*when talking *about* yourself and another person(s)

2nd person

**Tú** = You (informal, casual)

\*talking *to* a friend

**Vosotros/Vosotras** = You guys / Y'all

males/  
mixed group ↙

↳ all females

\*talking *to* a group of people

→ Only used in Spain

3rd person

**Él** = He

\*talking *about* a boy

**Ellos** = they (masculine)

\*talking *about* a group of guys or guys and girls

**Ella** = She

\*talking *about* a girl

**Ellas** = they (feminine)

\*talking *about* a group of girls

**Usted (Ud.)** = You (formal, polite)

\*talking *to* someone older

**Ustedes (Uds.)** = You guys / Y'all

\*talking *to* a group of people

Any name, singular subject and the word "it" falls in this category as well. We'll talk about this later 😊

When studying the Subject Pronouns I expect you to use this same grid format ALL times.
